**COVID-19 Campus Access Protocol for Spread Prevention**  
**June 3 & 4 Pick-Up & Drop-Off Days at the US**

In order to protect you, the greater K-12 school community, and fellow Marylanders, AACS will not allow faculty, staff, students, families, or visitors access to our building facilities on June 3 and 4, 2020 until the following protocols are satisfactorily completed:

- Health Inventory Questionnaire answers confirm that the individual is not likely to be infected or infect others.
- The individual agrees to maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet.
- The individual agrees to wear a mask at all times while on AACS property.
- The temperature of the individual is lower than 100F degrees.
- Mask is properly in place, covering the nose and mouth of the individual.
- The individual disinfects hands with hand sanitizer in front of an AACS employee.

**Please be prepared to answer the following health inventory questions by a member of the AACS faculty and staff upon arrival.**

- ❖ Have you or anyone in your household been exposed to someone COVID-19 positive in the last 14 days?
- ❖ Do you or does anyone in your household have a temperature 100F or higher?
- ❖ Do you or does anyone in your household have any of the following symptoms, which are new or different than usual in the last 10 days?
  - cough
  - shortness of breath
  - body aches/ Muscle pain
  - nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
  - loss of sense of smell or taste
  - headache
  - sore throat

If any of these are answered "yes," the student and household member with them will be asked to leave campus immediately and wait at least 14-days before returning.
